

HOBBY SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entrant must be a member registered at the Rally.
2. Entrant may exhibit in as many different categories of the Hobby show as they wish.
3. Entrant must decide in which group of a category he/she wishes to enter.
4. Entrant must exhibit only his/her own work or collection.
5. The same exhibit may not be entered in the Art Show. Exhibitor must decide which to enter.
6. Entries which have won a ribbon at either of the last two Region 9 Rallies may be exhibited as a "not for competition" display only.
7. Entries which have won a first place award at earlier Region 9 Rallies may be entered for competition if at least 50% of the display is new or different.
8. All entrants must register for the Show at Rally site.
9. Exhibits are limited in size to a table area of not over 2 ½ X 8 unless special arrangements are made with the Committee.
10. Only those exhibitors enrolled in the categories of the current show will be permitted in the show room during the set-up period. They may have an assistant if necessary.
11. The exhibitor is solely responsible for the set-up protection, and safety of the exhibit. It must be removed and the area left clean at the end of the show.
12. The exhibitor's membership number must be displayed on the exhibit at all times during the show.
13. You can only win one first place award in one category. If you are entered in all the categories and you receive another high score you cannot win that first place ribbon.
14. Only those awards authorized by the Region 9 Rally Committee may be displayed. Awards made by the authorized judges are final.
15. Exhibits must be set-up between 9:30 am and 10:00 am on Wednesday, April 2.
16. Judging will be from 10:00 am to 10:30 am. No exhibitors are allowed in the show area during this time.
17. Hobby Show general viewing from 10:30 am to 12:00 pm.
